Foster's Grille opening in Waynesboro

A new family restaurant specializing in burgers opens Wednesday in Martin's Plaza at 437 Tiffany Drive in Waynesboro.

Foster's Grille now has 23 locations rang-

ing from Northern Virginia to North Carolina and Florida.

The newest location will offer the half-pound "Charburger," as well as hand-cut french fries and milkshakes.

Bob Harchar, the co-owner of the Waynesboro location, said the menu will also offer chicken breast sandwiches, chicken wings, hot dogs and lighter fare such as chicken fingers and grilled cheese sandwiches for kids.

"We will offer a family friendly environment that includes a party room for birthday parties," Harchar said.

To order, customers print their name at the top of the Foster's menu pad and customize an order to their liking.

Harchar estimates the restaurant can handle about 118 customers, who will sit in a dining room with the Foster's Grille late model stock car hanging from the ceiling.

The chain was founded by Shawn Foster,

the former executive chef of the Palm Restaurant in Atlanta.

The Waynesboro location will be open Sunday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Friday and Saturday from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m.
