Haven't been to Foster's in a while, mostly because I'm a new healthier eating machine. But if you love burgers and love wings, this is the best place in Fairfax County for either.

The burgers are grilled, and taste like your dad grilled them out on the back porch. If I recall correctly, you can actually get a small burger, which is a patty half the size of the usual. Fries are great too.

The wings are also excellent, the best in the area that I can think of. Haven't been at happy hour in a while, but as I recall they have some decent after work beer specials. While the beer selection isn't huge, the place also isn't packed to the gills either.

One thing to be aware of: last I remember they didn't take credit cards. They do have one of those little "pay a \$2.50 fee" ATMs in there, but otherwise be sure to swing by the bank before you stop in.

One final note: apparently there is a Foster's coming soon in those newly built shops in Old Town Fairfax. Might have to suspend my healthy eating habits for that at some point. :)

Tucked away in a crowded shopping center, Foster's proved to be a surprise gem in Vienna. They are few and far between, and very few people talk/think about Foster's when they want a burger, but they provide a fantastic burger and will hopefully continue to expand and create more franchises to combat this unjustifiable Five Guys rage that has overtaken the area.

Similar to Fuddrucker's, and the aforementioned Five Guys, Foster's has self seating and no wait staff. You order by placing a check mark on a paper menu next to the item(s) you want and then circle the toppings. All sandwiches come with fries and a drink, which is kind of irritating to be forced to buy but I'm sure you could get just the sandwich if you tried hard enough. Then again, with such great fries, why would you want just a sandwich? More on that later.

The "charburger" is the signature item on the menu and it lives up to its name. A thick, but not excessive, patty is grilled with an excellent charred outside but juicy inside. It rests on a soft but substantial sesame seed bun and is the perfect size. The fries are great as well. They are very similar to boardwalk fries but feel a bit thicker and crispy. Excellent flavor, especially once you load it up with salt and vinegar!

They are building a Foster's near my work which I'm very excited about so hopefully the word about them will get out soon!
